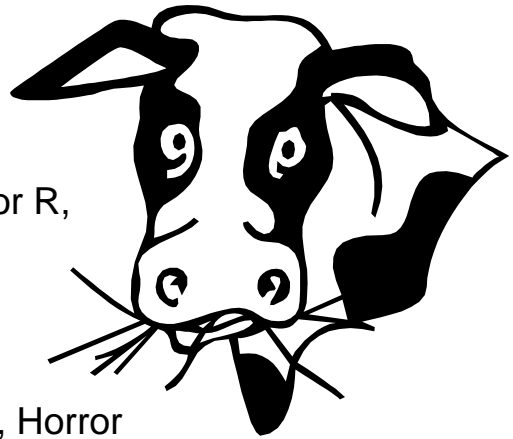


GOING TO THE MOO-VIES?

1. Set up a new database using the list of fields below. Save this database as **Movies by Your Name.**

- MOVIE TITLE
- LEADING MALE ACTOR
- LEADING FEMALE ACTOR
- LENGTH OF MOVIE (IN MINUTES)
- RATING (Validation Rule & Text for R, PG-13, PG, G)
- ANIMALS INVOLVED (Yes/No)
- DIRECTOR'S LAST NAME
- GENRE (Use Validation Rule & Text for Drama, Comedy, Action, Horror or D, C, A, H)



2. In datasheet view, fill in information on **at least** 15 Movies (bonus awarded for more than 15 movies – up to 25). To find the information on Movies, you can do a web search on google.com or yahoo.com or go to→
